From BZQ Version 4.11 the Portamento command is supported.

Portamento is written by a digit (0 to 9) and one of the letters J, j, Ξ , ξ .

The digit (0 -9) is for the extent of Portamento. 0 means no Portamento, and 9 is the maximum (e.g. as used by Archon Protopsaltis Stanitsas).

Example:

7ξνπβ0ξπνζ or with Latin letters: 7j n p b 0j p n z

In this example, Portamento of extent 7 will apply for the 3 first notes ni pa bou and will become zero for the rest of the melody.

A simple example of a melody with Portamento: Tin timioteran, tone 8, ni and ga:

Synthetic voice PKOY of greatest pitch precision, without portamento:<u>BZQ.Timiotera 8 Ni and ga Q5 PKOY Is9 R0 Y2 0%-</u> WITHOUT PORTAMENTO.mp3

Similarly with portamento 9: <u>BZQ.Timiotera 8 Ni and</u> ga Q5 PKOY Is9 R0 Y2 0%-FULL PORTAMENTO.mp3

Human voice FCHAR, with portamento 9 and Reverb: <u>BZQ.Timiotera 8 Ni and ga_Q5_FCHAR_Is9_R0_Y2_0%-</u> FULL PORTAMENTO-REVERB.mp3
